**Policies & Procedures for faculty and presenters at AACS or CSF sponsored meetings**

- 1) Faculty presenters and moderators at all AACS, CSF and its affiliates' sponsored meetings, implicitly through their participation, agree to abide by all Academy and Foundation policies and procedures. Any questions regarding the policies or the official Code of Ethics should be directed to headquarters.
- 2) Presenters at Academy meetings are required to submit an original paper suitable for first run printing in the American Journal of Cosmetic Surgery. These manuscripts should be addressed to the Foundation headquarters office, prior to the meeting. Please refer to the Journal's "Instructions to Authors", available from AACS headquarters or contained on page 2 of the Resident Paper Contest informational packet. Abstracts submitted for consideration for the program may be printed in the Journal, regardless of their acceptance to the program, depending on available space.
- 3) All faculty presenters are expected to pay the designated registration fee for the meeting, unless otherwise notified in writing.
- 4) All faculty presenters are required to make full disclosure of any fiduciary or proprietary connections both prior to and during the presentation.
- 5) In keeping with its continuing education efforts, the AACS and the CSF from time to time record and duplicate presentations given at their meetings. Understanding the advantages of this service to the association and its members, each presenter is requested to consent to the recording (visual and/or audio) and duplicating of any presentation, to be offered for sale to conference participants, as well as for future sales and educational endeavors. This in no way prevents the presenter from using his own material in subsequent presentations.
- 6) The standard audio-visual equipment for each meeting is defined at the beginning of each meeting. Should a presenter request alternate equipment, that presenter will be required to share the cost of the equipment (up to 50%) with the Academy or the Foundation, unless a minimum of 5% of the faculty request the same item, in which case it will be considered standard equipment for the meeting.

**Instructions for Submission of Abstracts**

1. Abstracts must be limited to no more than 300 words maximum.
2. The body of the abstract should include:
  - a. A brief statement of purpose of the study, procedure, etc.
  - b. The methods of study or approach clearly defined
  - c. A summary of the results and/or conclusions of the study, including sufficient details to support those conclusions.
3. Abstracts frequently obscure the value of their content because they are poorly organized. It is important that the methods and results be clearly defined in the abstract; general statements such as "results will be presented" are discouraged as the abstracts are meant to be educational and informative in and of themselves. When a procedure or method is stated to have "advantages", these advantages should be defined. Abstracts that simply summarize results without defining objectives and methods are equally undesirable.
4. Submission of an abstract signifies acceptance of the Educational Program Committee's decision regarding presentation of the paper or course, following the abstract selection process.

**Disclosure Procedure**

It is required by the American Academy of Cosmetic Surgery, in accordance with ACCME regulations, that all presenters disclose any financial interest or other relationship (grant, research support, consultant, etc.) by any of the authors with any manufacturer or commercial products that may be discussed in the presentation. It is requested that you review each statement carefully to determine if a disclosure statement is needed.

**#1 Commercial Promotion**

The promotion of any commercial product which would provide direct or indirect benefit to the presenter is not permitted. This includes instruments, devices, franchised surgical procedures or cosmetic products. The incorporation of these products in a scientific program is acceptable if the use is not designed for promotional purpose. The use of generic names is encouraged for references to medications.

**#2 Secret Methods**

Presentations which do not include a complete discussion of the theory, methodology and medications employed are prohibited. Since the Academy is an educational organization, the purpose of the presentation is to inform and instruct the audience on not only patient selection and patient improvement, but more vitally, the method which can attain such an improvement.

**#3 Discrimination and Vulgarity**

Speakers may not use vulgar language or include material in a presentation which will be discriminatory in any manner. Stories, anecdotes, jokes or comic cartoons which are sexual in connotation or discriminatory are not permitted. Any derogatory comment concerning age, sex, marital status, religion or ethnic background is prohibited. The content of the material presented both verbally and visually must be such to be acceptable for publication in a scientific journal.
