If identical bids are submitted, CSF will give precedence to the order in which they are received.

Every bid is contractually binding. By placing his or her signature on the bid sheet, the bidder agrees to pay for the item if he or she has the highest bid at the close of the auction. Changing your mind is not a valid reason for retracting a bid. Before bidding, carefully review the listing.
